Top 10 Australians plus Internationals to go through to A Finals in K1M, K1W, C1M, & C1W categories

B Finals will be run in K1M, K1W, C1M & C1W categories.

Winners of C2M, C2W, C2Mx will be the best of Run 1 & 2 from Day 1.

Teams

Team Events will be **one run only** and must be Club / School based teams.

Team Age Categories: Junior (14 & under), Senior (18 & under, unless full time student) and Masters (all age categories).

Each State may enter as many teams as they like, provided all paddlers compete for the same club/school.

Individual athletes may join together to form an independent team but the Organising Committee must approve the team's constitution. No composite State teams will be recognized.

Paddlers may only enter one event.
